The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 62 dated 25.04.2016 registered at Police Station Sector 16, Faridabad under Sections 354-B, 352 and 511 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that challan has been presented and charge has been framed and the co-accused have been allowed bail. He further states that the complainant has not disclosed that she was a police official and she had made a statement on 05.05.2016 that compromise has been effected and she has not objection if the applicants were released on bail.

Learned State counsel submits that subsequently the complainant had changed her statement.

Allegations under Section 354-B IPC have been levelled by the police official. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that minor altercation had been taken place and the case has been registered and Section 354-B IPC had been added.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the investigation is over and trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
