This petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.109 dated 06.12.2014, registered under Sections 302 and 324 IPC, at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

It is contended that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case. There is no other male member in the family to look after the mother who is suffering from cancer. The petitioner is in custody since 08.12.2014.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel, submits all the witnesses including DWs have been examined in the present case and the case is at the fag end.

Considering the fact that the trial is at the fag end, therefore, this Court is not inclined to go into the merits of the case. Dismissed.

However, keeping in view the fact that the mother of the petitioner is a known patient of cancer and is terminally sick. Therefore, the State is directed to verify the fact with regard to the illness of the mother. If the assertion raised by the petitioner is found to be factually correct, in that eventuality, he may be taken to the concerned hospital to meet his mother under proper police security for two hours and be lodged back on the same day in the jail. The time and date of his visit shall be notified by the concerned Superintendent Jail on receipt of the report by the State.
