By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for protecting their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 by providing them necessary/adequate security and further not to implicate petitioner No.2 in any false case of abduction of petitioner No.1.

During the pendency of the instant petition and after issuance of notice of motion, petitioners, namely, Mandeep Kaur and Vinod Kumar appeared before DSP, Banga, District Shahid Bhagat Singh Nagar (Nawanshahr).

Mandeep Kaur made a statement before DSP to the effect that she is major and has solemnized marriage with Vinod Kumar at her will and volition. Her parents and other family members were not happy and as such, the petitioners were feeling apprehension to their life and liberty at their instance. Due to the said reason, the instant petition was filed, however, at present there is no apprehension or danger to their life and

liberty at the hands of the private respondents. They do not want to require any security and the petition be consigned to the records. The statement of Mandeep Kaur has been fully endorsed by Vinod Kumar.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by the petitioner before DSP, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and the same stands disposed of accordingly.
