The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 70 dated 17.05.2014 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Machhiwara Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the matter could not be settled at the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

The dispute remains between the parties regarding recovery of 13 tolas of Gold.

However, after hearing learned counsel for the parties, order dated 24.07.2014 is made absolute, subject to the condition that petitioner will make F.D.R of Rs.5 lakhs, in favour of his wife, Praveen Kaur and submit it before the trial Court. The decision with regard to release of the above said amount will be seen by the trial Court at the final stage.
