The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.83, dated 11.5.2016, registered under Sections 147, 149, 186, 353, 447, 511, 506, 153-A of the IPC, at Police Station Chhappar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Allegations are that the petitioner along with other persons made encroachment on government land and was making speeches that no body would be allowed to remove their possession.

Learned DAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, states that the encroachment stands removed.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 3.8.2016 or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires his presence, and in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
