The present petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.69 dated 29.1.2015 under Sections 406, 419, 420, 120-B IPC and Sections 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, District Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to respond to the query made by the Court as to how the second application after addition of Sections 467, 468, 471 IPC is maintainable in the situation when the earlier bail application under Sections 406, 419, 420 and 120-B IPC stands dismissed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 31.5.2016. The allegations against the petitioner are that the petitioner duped the complainant by inducing him to deposit Rs.7 lacs in the account of Amar Lal with a branch of a bank on the pretext that another account alongwith ATM machine of the same bank would be

got opened in the premises of the complainant. As the bail application stands already dismissed this cannot be said to be new circumstance in favour of the petitioner to file another bail application before this Court.

Dismissed.
