INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.39 dated 20.05.2016, registered at Police Station Jatusana, District Rewari, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468 and 471 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and perused the record.

From the record, I find that allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner and his father to the effect that the petitioner represented himself to be Reporter of Zee Punjab and Haryana and asked

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complainant-Om Parkash for ₹2,50,000/- to get the job for his son in railways.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has shown copy of complaint filed by present complainant, Om Parkash, against father of the present petitioner in the year 2014 in which allegations were made that father of the present petitioner had taken a loan of ₹2 lacs on 28.01.2014.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case at this stage and in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case, I find merit in the present petition and the same is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer with a further condition that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and join the investigation specifically on 24.09.2016 at 10.00 A.M. If the petitioner is not joined in the investigation on the said date, he can file application before Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewari for the purpose of getting him joined in the investigation. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
