Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 20.4.2014, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is not a beneficiary in the case and is a marginal witness in the alleged forged GPA. The petitioner is in custody since 24.5.2016. He further states that even otherwise in the main FIR, the parties have entered into a compromise.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 24.5.2016 and the parties have decided to compromise the matter, no purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner further in custody.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
