Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.51, dated 19.03.2015, under Section 22/61/85 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Zira, District Ferozepur.

Learned State counsel states that five out of eight prosecution witnesses have been examined and the the next date before the trial court is 02.12.2016 on which date the prosecution would make every endeavour to examine the remaining three prosecution witnesses and in any case they would be examined by the next date of hearing.

In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, at the fag end of the trial, I am not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner.
