HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.920 dated 29.12.2015 under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC, at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

The petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law, respectively of the deceased wife.

The allegation in the FIR is that the younger sister of the complainant was found dead on 29.12.2015 on account of burn injuries. It has been stated that before her death, she was being harassed by the petitioners and their son (husband of deceased) and demand of dowry was constantly made.

It is not disputed that husband of the deceased i.e. son of the petitioners is also behind bars.

At this stage, Ld. counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not want to press the present application qua petitioner No.2 father-in-law. Regarding petitioner No.1, he states that the deceased has left behind a daughter aged about 08 months and in the absence of the family members, she is presently being looked after by the relatives of the petitioners. He states that in the absence of petitioner No.1 welfare of the child is not being properly

taken care of. Petitioner No.1 is in custody since 18.02.2016.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, petition is allowed qua Dharamwati-petitioner No.1. She is directed to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridabad.

The petition is dismissed as not pressed qua Sheesh Pal-petitioner No.2.
