The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. April 18, 2015 for having been found in possession of 1 kg of Charas which will fall in the category of non-commercial quantity.

It is appreciable in this case that out of 13 total witnesses 12 have already been examined but the next date of hearing before the trial Court is July 5, 2016.

The quantity of Charas being non-commercial, the petitioner, irrespective of the stage of the trial can be granted the concession of regular bail in order to give him a fair opportunity to lead his defence and contest the case properly.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
