This is a petition for anticipatory bail.

On 14.06.2016 the following order was passed:-

“ Present petition has been filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.37, dated 09.05.2016 under Sections 308, 336, 341, 323, 148, 149, IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that name of the petitioner does not figure in the FIR in question, and as such, no injury has been attributed to him.

Notice of motion, returnable for 21.09.2016.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to

appear before the Investigating Officer and to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2)Cr.P.C.

Today learned Addl.AG, on instructions from ASI Deep Singh, has stated that the challan has been presented, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Consequently the petition is allowed and the order dated 14.06.2016 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
