Petitioners seek concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Junior Engineer Sumer Singh alleging that on 22.01.2016, the petitioners along with 30-40 persons constituted an unlawful assembly and created obstructions in the official duty of the complainant to remove the illegal encroachments from the drains of Mathura Road. No specific injury has been attributed to the petitioners.

On the instructions of ASI Puran Singh, it has been informed that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. Interim order dated 29.07.2016 is hereby made absolute. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioners, they will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that they will not tamper with the evidence and will not commit similar offence of which they are accused of, during the entire period of trial.
