Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.9 dated 07.01.2015, registered under Sections 323/376 IPC (Section 120-B/420/216/506 IPC, Police Station DLF-II, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon (Haryana)).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to orders dated 23.06.2015/10.08.2015, passed by the co-ordinate Benches, the petitioner has come to India and has joined the investigation.

Complainant is present in person who asks for a pass over. Counsel for the petitioner has expressed her inability to appear after lunch session. Complainant further states that the matter has been compromised.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and orders dated 23.06.2015/10.08.2015, granting interim relief to the petitioner are made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
