Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.69 dated 29.5.2016 under Sections 323, 341, 427, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 16.6.2016 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Baljit Singh, does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, however, he submits that recovery of *dang* and *kirpan* is yet to be effected from the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the allegations levelled against the petitioner whereupon the present FIR was registered and the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 16.6.2016 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
