Vide this common order, above mentioned two petitions are being
disposed of as they arise from the same FIR.

These are two petitions filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of
anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0037, dated 21.04.2016, registered under
Sections 420,467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station
Sirhind, Fatehgarh Sahib.

On 16.06.2016 the following order was recorded in CRM-M-21240-

2016:

“Contends that the Civil Suits for permanent injunction and partition are pending before the Court. The matter is purely civil in nature. Even the mutation has been entered into as per the natural succession. FIR is nothing, but an act of harassment and pressure tactics.

Notice of motion for 04.08.2016.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. he will join the investigation as and when required.”

Learned Addl. A.G., Punjab on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, accepts that these civil suits are pending.

In this view of the matter, both the petitions are allowed and interim orders dated 16.06.2016 passed in CRM-M-21240-2016 and dated 20.06.2016 passed in CRM-M-21567-2016 are made absolute.
