Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Mr. D. D. Sharma, Advocate appearing on behalf of respondent no.2-Narcotics Control Bureau, Chandigarh makes statement that he was handed over the copies of the letter No.1012-NCB/2016 dated 13.05.2016 under the signature of Deputy Directory, NCB, Zone-Chandigarh, UT on the last date of hearing along with two documents namely test memo and on more letter No.1/ND/R/2015/CLD-954(N) dated 30.11.2015 issued by Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Revenue, Central Revenues Control Laboratory, New Delhi. These three documents are taken on record and marked together as Mark X for identification. Mr. D. D. Sharma, Advocate has today handed over before me a letter dated 22/23.08.2016 signed by Superintendent, NCM, Government of India, MHA, Chandigarh. It is also taken on record and marked as X-1 for identification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the document X was handed over by the wife of petitioner No.1 to him.

Perusal of letter X-1 dated 22/23.08.2016 shows that the document X is forged and was never issued from their office. The NCB is, therefore, at liberty to take such steps as available in law against the petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners wants to withdraw the present petition. He is allowed to do so.

However, the liberty is in favour of respondent No.2 to take such action against the petitioners according to law as is permissible.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
