This is an application for anticipatory bail filed in
FIR No. 28 dated 30.03.2016 under Section 324 and 326 read with
Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Shri
Muktsar Sahib.

On 15.06.2016, this Court had passed the following
order:-

“Contends that there is already a civil litigation
pending, much less FIR registered by the mother of
the petitioner against the complainant and the present
FIR is a counter blast. In fact, the complainant had
entered the house of the petitioner and molested his
sister. The report of Radiologist is still awaited. It

cannot be ascertained at this stage whether offence under Section 326 IPC is made out or not. He further contends that two other co-accused have been granted prearrest bail by the Additional Sessions Judge vide order dated 6.5.2016 (Annexure P-8).

Notice of motion for 1.8.2016.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. He will join the investigation as and when required. .”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance of the order dated 15.6.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 15.6.2016, passed by this Court is made absolute.
