Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC on 5.8.2010 is for quashing of FIR No.79 dated 16.6.2010 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Roop Nagar, District Ropar (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Suresh Kumar,

submits that in the trial Court, the prosecution has examined as many as 5 witnesses and only 3 witnesses are required to be examined.

Taking into consideration the advance stage of trial, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the present petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to take all possible pleas available to the petitioner before the trial Court.
