The petitioner is alleged to be a member of gang of car thieves. He has been involved in the case on the basis of the disclosure statement of his co-accused to the effect that the petitioner was responsible for change of the registration number plates.

On the instructions of ASI Ramesh Kumar, it has been informed that the petitioner is involved in two other cases of similar nature, but has been granted bail in those cases. It has also been informed that he has already joined the investigation and

recoveries have already been effected.

In the said circumstances, it does not appear to be a case where custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

The petition is allowed. Interim order, dated 16.06.2016, is hereby made absolute subject to all the conditions contained under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C., with an additional condition that the petitioner will not indulge in similar activities during the pendency of the trial, in case the prosecution agency opts to present challan against him.
