Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of F.I.R No. 09 of 24.02.2016, under Section 406/498-A IPC, registered at P.S. Bholath, District Kapurthala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Gurjaswant Singh, has informed the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 30.06.2016 and custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no longer required.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further informed the Court that the matter stands compromised between the parties and quashing petition is pending before this Court.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 16.06.2016 passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim

anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C

However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh bail bonds after presentation of the challan.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
