The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.1038 dated 17.10.2015, under Sections 409, 420, 468, 471, 120-B, IPC and 7, 13, 49 & 88 of Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

The allegation against the petitioner is that while posted as Kanungo, he prepared 'Fard Badar' against the rule in an unlawful manner in connivance with his non-applicants (accused) namely Parmod Chahal, Tehildar and Tej Pal, Patwari.

Heard.

It is admitted by the learned State counsel that above-said

co-accused Parmod Chahal, Tehsildar and Tej Pal, Patwari have already been granted the benefit of regular bail by this Court vide order dated 9.5.2016 passed in CRM-M-6138 of 2016 and vide order dated 16.6.2016 passed in CRM-M-20645 of 2016, respectively. Then it is also admitted that challan in this case has already presented in the Court.

Nothing more is required to be recovered from the present petitioner. He was arrested in this case on 4.2.2016 and since then he is in judicial custody. The trial of this case will take some time for its disposal.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
