Mr. Nonish Kumar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.4 and 5 and accepts notice on their behalf.

Parents of the girl are present in the Court and on direction by this Court, girl has spoken to her parents. Her parents has blessed both the petitioners in the court.

The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect their life and liberty from the hands of private respondents.

Petitioners are stated to be major and have solemnized marriage on 14.06.2016 which is against the wishes of their parents. Factum of marriage has been pleaded with reference to photographs (Annexure P-4). Petitioners have an apprehension at the hands of private respondents Nos.4 to 6 and in this regard they have submitted a representation dated 14.06.2016 (Annexure P-5) to the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad-respondent No.2, but no action has been taken so far.

The present petition is disposed of with the direction to Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad-respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners and decide the same and if required, provide the protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate security.

The Criminal Misc. petition stands disposed of.
