Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of order dated 02.06.2016 (Annexure P-10) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fazilka-III in FIR No.24 dated 30.03.2012 registered at P.S. Sadar Abohar, Ferozepur under Sections 365/ 382/ 452/ 506/ 427/148/149 IPC and 21/27/25 of Arms Act, 1959 whereby despite rejection of anticipatory bail pertaining to enhanced charges under Sections 392/395 IPC and continuous non-appearance by the accused, the learned Court instead of issuing non-bailable warrants granted exemption from appearance to the accused.

Written reply on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 filed in Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of order of even date passed in the connected case i.e. CRM-M-No.22185 of 2016-

Samarbir Singh and another Versus State of Punjab, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
