In FIR No.633 dated 24.12.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Palam Vihar, District Gurgaon, the petitioners were arrested and are in jail since then. Admittedly, the challan has been filed before the trial Judge and the offences are triable by the Magistrate. The trial will take its own time. There is no point in continuing the petitioners under trial.

In that view of the matter, particularly when the petitioners says that the matter has compromised, bail petition is allowed. Petitioners be released on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate on such terms and conditions as may deem fit and proper by the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
