Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that for the relief claimed in the present petition, they had moved a representation dated 02.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) to respondents No.3 i.e. SHO, Police Station, Valtoha, District-Tarn Taran, but no action has been taken thereon.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 02.06.2016 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioners.
