The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.), has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.94 dated 28.08.2015, registered under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, Distt. Fazilka.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that there is no evidence on record with regard to the entrustment of the amount in question by the complainant. In fact brother of the petitioner, namely, Sunil Kumar himself is running brick kiln. He further states that co-accused, namely, Amrik Singh and Sunil Kumar @ Sanju have already been allowed bail by this Court vide Annexures P-4 and P-5.

The learned counsel for the petitioners further states that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the order passed by this Court on 17.06.2016.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 17.06.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
