The writ petition has been filed to quash the FIR No.28 dated 1.2.2012
appended as Annexure P-1 registered under Section 24 of the Emigration Act, 1982, at
Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh.

The learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that
the petition may be disposed of with a direction to the Court concerned to complete
the trial pending for a long time.

In view of the above limited prayer now sought for by the writ
petitioner, no necessity has arisen to issue notice to respondents.

A direction is issued to the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Chandigarh
to conclude the trial relating to FIR No.28 dated 1.2.2012, registered under Section
24 of the Emigration Act at Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh within three months
from the date of this order. As the petitioners have been appearing before the said
Court right from the date of trial, their presence before the trial Court shall stand
dispensed with, unless their presence is very much required for any particular hearing.
They be permitted to appear through their counsel during trial.

This petition is disposed of with the above said direction.

concerned.
