By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.28, dated 31.03.2016, registered under Sections 326, 452 read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the MLR of co-accused Dilbag Singh to contend that in this case said Dilbag Singh also received injuries in the alleged occurrence which fact has been concealed by the police in the registration of this case. He further states that in pursuance of the order dated 20.06.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.06.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
