This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate direction to the respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner at the instance of respondents No.4 to 7 and not to intrude into the privacy of the petitioner as respondents No. 4 to 7 are forcing petitioner to get married without her wishes/consent and further threatening to eliminate her.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer only to the extent that the representation dated 16.06.2016 (Annexure P-2) moved to SSP, Moga by petitioner Varinder Kaur may be considered. On the other hand, learned State counsel has no objection to that.

In view of above fact, respondent No.2-SSP, Moga is directed

to look into the said representation (Annexure P-2) as per law within two month, after receiving the certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
