Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in case FIR No.198 dated 04.11.2014 under Sections 399, 402, 411, 414, 120-B IPC, Sections 21, 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, Section 25 of the Arms Act and Sections 3, 34, 20 of IP Act registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala.

The said FIR was registered on the basis of secret information that the petitioner along with others had gathered at an old Brick Kiln to plan for dacoity. The FIR was registered without effecting any recovery and without arresting any person in FIR No.198 of 2014. So far as the petitioner is concerned, the petitioner was arrested on 29.06.2015.

No recovery was effected from the petitioner. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 29.06.2015. Co-accused of the petitioner, similarly circumstanced, has been granted concession of bail vide a separate order passed today in the same FIR.

In view of said circumstances, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
