This order shall dispose of above referred two petitions. For the sake of convenience the facts are being taken from CRM-M-21495 of 2016.

These are two petitions, one bearing CRM-M-22322 of 2016 filed by the complainant for cancellation of regular bail of the husband-respondent No.2-Satpal and one bearing CRM-M-21495 of 2016 for anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner-Mahesh Sood w/o Satpal.

After arguing for sometime the following agreed order is passed :-

Complainant-Chamkaur Singh undertakes to return the amount of Rs.5.00 lacs which has been paid to him by the husband-respondent No.2 in CRM-M-22322 of 2016. On the other side said respondent No.2-husband and petitioner-Mahesh Sood-wife in anticipatory bail in CRM-M-21495 of 2016 shall surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail which shall be decided on merits. It is directed that they will surrender on 29.08.2016 and on that date the complainant will handover a draft of Rs.5.00 lacs in favour of the husband-Satpal. In case the amount is not paid the petition for cancellation of bail would be deemed to be dismissed and the petitioner-Mahesh Sood be entitled to be released on bail.

Both the petitions stand disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
