Impugned in the present revision is the order dated 18.8.2010, passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mansa, vide which, accused Mohammad Yamal alias Chottu was declared juvenile offender. The revision filed before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Mansa was dismissed on 24.4.2013.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have also carefully gone through the file.

The order of the lower Court shows that before the lower Court the transfer certificate was produced which was relied upon. No contrary certificate of school was produced to show that the date of birth is different than alleged by the applicant. Therefore, after recording evidence of both the parties, the learned Additional Chief

Judicial Magistrate, Mansa has passed the order. There is no illegality or infirmity in the said order.

Consequently, the present revision petition stands dismissed.
