Report dated 17.08.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Mohan Singh, Manjit Kaur, Mangjeet Singh, Baljeet Singh, Nirmal Singh @ Nimma. Jaspal Singh and Amarjit Kaur as well as of complainant Amrik Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a case of cross-version and that offences are of not heinous nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR Criminal 1052**, Rapat No.18 dated 9.2.2013 in FIR No. 12

dated 07.02.2013 under Sections 323,324,325,326,148 and 149 IPC, Police Station, Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
