The present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 100 dated 11.06.2015 under Section 306 IPC, P.S.-Moga City, District-Moga.

The allegation against the present petitioner is that he and his brother told the daughter of the complainant that she brought lesser amount from her parents due to which quarrel took place between the brother of the petitioner and his wife (deceased). Further the allegation against the present petitioner is that he pushed the complainant. Thereafter, the daughter of the complainant committed suicide.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, from Head Constable Surinder Singh has informed that the husband of deceased i.e. Vijay Kumar was released on bail. Further after framing of the charges, the trial is fixed for recording of evidence of the prosecution witnesses.

The only allegation against the present petitioner that he

accompanied his brother and was present in the house when the daughter of the complainant committed suicide.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of the trial of the present case, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Moga.
