Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions for entrustment of investigation of the case FIR No.05 dated 22.01.2016 for offence under Sections 323, 325, 308 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, Distt. Hoshiarpur to an independent agency or to some higher rank officer not below the rank of S.S.P.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the aforesaid FIR was registered by the police, but investigation in the case has not been completed. He further submits that petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 21.04.2016 (Annexure P-2) to respondent

No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, but no action has been taken thereon.
