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**TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA. J (ORAL)**

Petitioners seek benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.633 dated 26.11.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 342, 506, 452, 365 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Gharaunda, District Karnal.

FIR was registered on the statement of Devender alias Babloo. Complainant had stated that he had given Rs.2 lac on interest to petitioner No.1 Suresh through Alwar Jhiwar on 15.06.2012 at 2% interest per annum and a cheque of the same amount had been given to him as security. Upon money being demanded back, Suresh had put off the matter on one pretext or the other. On 24.11.2015, at about 7.30 a.m. both the petitioners along with co-accused Sonu and Promila had attacked the complainant and thereafter had snatched a gold chain of 5 tolas, cash of Rs.12,000/- as also one mobile phone.

Insofar as petitioner No.1 is concerned, he is stated to

have given a danda blow on the left ear of the complainant. No overt act is attributed to petitioner No.2, namely, Parveen. Co-accused Sonu is stated to have given a saria blow on the head of the complainant.

Petitioners were arrested on 11.12.2015.

It has gone uncontroverted that co-accused Sonu who had allegedly given a saria blow on the head of the complainant has been granted benefit of regular bail .

Learned State counsel would concede that the injuries on the person of complainant Devender have been opined to be simple in nature.

Under such circumstances, petitioners are held entitled to the benefit of bail. Petition is allowed. Petitioners be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.

Disposed of.
