Petitioner had been arrested on 29.9.2015 for having been found in possession of 260 grams of heroin which is marginally higher than the commercial quantity prescribed. He was granted concession of interim bail during the period the report of Forensic Science Laboratory was awaited. He has surrendered after the report of Chemical Examiner was received.

Taking into consideration the fact that quantity is slightly higher than the commercial quantity prescribed and he had not misused the liberty granted and only one witness having been examined till date, he can be granted concession of bail subject to the condition that he will not indulge in similar activity again during the pendency of trial.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court subject to the aforesaid condition.
