The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.45 dated 20.04.2016 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that some dowry articles have been recovered from the petitioner and no custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required further.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.2/complainant submits that 5 tolas of gold articles are yet to be recovered from the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of and the order dated 22.06.2016 is made absolute subject to depositing of surety of Rs.1,00,000/- with the learned trial Court.
