On the instructions of Inspector Satpal Singh, it has been informed that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The petitioner is alleged to have acted as a conduit between the complainant and co-accused Darshan Singh.

During course of investigation, recording of demand between the petitioner and complainant, has been obtained. In the present case, recovery has not been effected from any one and the FIR was registered on the basis of phone call received on the toll free number of the Vigilance Department.

The culpability of the petitioner is apparently a debatable issue during course of investigation.

In view of said circumstances, the petitioner can be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting

officer subject to the conditions that he will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner.

In case of any allegation of non-cooperation during course of investigation, it will be open to the prosecution agency to seek cancellation of bail.
