This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.86 dated 27.05.2016 registered at Police Station Kalka, District Panchkula under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC and Sections 10/16/24 of Emigration Act, 1983.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would not press this petition and would surrender before the trial Court but a direction should be issued to the trial Court to decide the application for regular bail, to be moved by the petitioner, expeditiously.

Learned Deputy Advocate General states that he would have no objection if this course of action is followed.

In the circumstances, it is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court on or before 08.08.2016 and moves an application for regular bail the same be decided by the trial Court expeditiously but in any case on or before 11.08.2016.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
