A.B. CHAUDHARI, J

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect her life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the marriage of the petitioner and respondent No.4 was solemnized in the year 2009. Thereafter, there was some matrimonial discord between the petitioner and respondent No.4 due to which they filed divorce petition and the same is pending in lower Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that now respondents No.4 to 6 who happens to be the Husband, Brother-in-Law and Mother-in-Law, respectively, of the petitioner, are harassing and threatening to kill her. In this regard, petitioner is stated to have moved a representation (Annexure P-1) to Superintendent of Police, Karnal, but no action has been taken so far.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, Superintendent of Police, Karnal, respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner and if required, take necessary remedial measures.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
