A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):

The petitioner seeks the grant of orders of anticipatory bail in FIR No.33 dated 28.4.2016, registered under Sections 307, 325, 323, 294, 148, 149 IPC, PS Division No.8, Ludhiana. This Court had made an interim order on 22.6.2016 ordering release of the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Learned State Counsel states that the offences are serious. She further submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, the offences being serious, relief of anticipatory bail should not be allowed. Counsel for the State further states that the injury was caused on the head. However, it appears that there is no fracture. In that view of the matter, I am inclined to extend the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The interim order dated 22.6.2016 is made absolute.
