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It has been stated in para 3 of the written statement dated
3.3.2004 as under:

“That it is submitted that recently on the issue of fixation of fees, the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its judgment dated 14.8.2003 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 350 of 1993-Islamic Academy of Education & another Vs. State of Karnataka & others has directed the States to set up a Fee Committee headed by a retired High Court Judge who shall be nominated by the Chief Justice of that State. The other member, who shall be nominated by the Judge should be a Chartered Accountant of repute. The third member would be representative of Medical Council of India or All India Council for Technical Education depending on the type of institution. The Secretary of the State Government in charge of Medical Education or Technical Education, as the case may be, shall be a Member Secretary of the Committee. The Committee should be free to nominate/co-opt independent person of repute so that the total numbers of the Committee does not exceed five. Each educational institute must place before this Committee, well in advance of the academic year, its proposal for fee structure. This proposal may be accepted by the Committee or Committee can fix other fee structure. The fee fixed by the Committee shall be binding for the period of three years. In accordance with the above direction of Hon'ble Apex

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Court the State of Haryana has constituted a Committee headed by Hon'ble Mr. Justice R.K.Nehru (Retd.) which has already started functioning."

As stated in this paragraph, according to us, this writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such. However, liberty is given to learned counsel for the petitioner to get the case revived in accordance with law, if so advised.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
