Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of order dated 23.06.2016, but 3.5 tolas of gold has not been recovered as he has sold the same to get his car repaired.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, order dated 23.06.2016 is made absolute subject to the petitioner furnishing surety of Rs.1 lac, before the trial Court.
