The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.46 dated 18.05.2016, registered under Sections 458, 323 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Boha, Distt. Mansa.

Heard.

On 23.06.2016, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.46 dated 18.05.2016 under Sections 458, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the present case is a cross case and a Rapat No.20 dated 12.05.2016, under Sections 427, 323, 148 and 149 IPC has been registered against Jagga Singh and others from the complainant side. He states that in fact the complainant party gave injuries to the petitioners side. He states that the injuries attributed to both the petitioners have been declared to be simple.

Notice of motion for 22.08.2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer, subject to the condition provided under 438(2) Cr.P.C. The petitioners are also directed to join the investigation and cooperate with the Investigating Agency, as and when required.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.06.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
