The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.217 dated 25.09.2015 registered under Section 411 IPC (Section 409 and 420 IPC added later on vide rapat dated 03.10.2015) at Police Station Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioners were granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 13.07.2016.

Status report filed by the State is taken on record. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, fairly submits that pursuant to order dated 13.07.2016 the petitioners indeed have joined the investigation and no custody is required.

Looking to the nature of offence, I am inclined to grant interim bail to the petitioners in terms of interim order dated 13.07.2016, which is made absolute.
