Without expression of any opinion regarding the extent of liability of the petitioner on the basis of the allegation that petitioner along with two brothers have received a sum of Rs. 60 lacs as earnest money and did not execute the sale deed, this is sufficient to observe that co-accused of petitioner, Paramjit Singh, has been granted the concession of bail on payment of sum of Rs. 6 lacs to the complainant within a period of two months after release on bail. The said amount is stated to have been paid. Counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is also ready to part with similar amount to seek his liberty without prejudice his legal rights.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in view of the fact that the material witnesses have already been examined and petitioner has been in custody with effect from 15.03.2016, on the principle of parity. Petitioner will be released on bail

on presentation of a bank draft of a sum of Rs.6 lacs (as undertaken by counsel for the petitioner) in the name of Prithvi Raj Soni and Davinder Kumar jointly and on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The trial Court shall hand over the bank draft to the complainant without prejudice to the rights of the complainant in the civil litigation or the criminal trial.
