The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0083 dated 15.06.2016 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468 & 471 read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Though it is true that the allegation against the petitioner that he has impersonated his brother in the examination is indeed serious offence, the learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that finally there is failure in the examination. The offence by the petitioner appears to be for the first time. Hence I make the following order:

ORDER

(i) The petitioner shall report to the police station concerned for joining the investigation.

(ii) The petitioner shall give undertaking to the police that he will not indulge in such type of offence in future.

(iii) The petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail in this FIR, on furnishing of his bail bond amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of arresting officer.
