The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.89 dated 04.06.2016 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 & 471 IPC at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and perused the order dated 27.06.2016.
